Please include any counselling courses or personal development work that you have undertaken.

### **Personal Statement**

Your personal statement should tell us why you are considering Brief Intervention Psychological Therapies training to the level you have indicated on the application form. Please tell us how you developed an interest in this course and why you consider you are suited to this training and work.

### **References**

Give the names and addresses of two referees with this application; the first referee should be from your current or most recent employer or academic institution; the second referee could be from another source. Please state the relationship between you and the referees who may not be friends or family members.

### **Early Application**

Please make your application as early as possible, interviews are conducted and places offered two to three months prior to the programme start. Following the interview and your acceptance on the course, you can reserve places on the modules of your choice. Modules are run subject to a minimum of students; in the event a module does not run or is full when you apply; a place will be reserved for you on the next dates for that module.
