# **Application for For RPL entry to MSc in TA Psychotherapy with CTA MSc in TA Counselling MSc in Brief Intervention Psychological Therapies MSc in Professional Supervision**

### **Students Applying for RPL entry to Transactional Analysis MSc Courses**

Students seeking RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) will fall into one of several categories

- 1) TA trainees who have completed 3 or 4 years of part-time TA psychotherapy training
- 2) Trainees who have completed all the requirements for entry to CTA
- 3) Psychotherapists who have passed the CTA written examination
- 4) Psychotherapists who have passed both the CTA written and oral examination and hold the qualification CTA(P)
- 5) Other TA trainees

For psychotherapy students the MSc is awarded with the CTA; holders of a CTA pass for their case study may be able to submit elements of the case study in a suitable form as the MSc project. The Counselling MSc is not tied to the CTA and is awarded on the basis of a 15,000 word MSc project.

### **Students Applying for RPL entry to Brief Intervention Psychological Therapies MSc Course**

Students seeking RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) will hold Degree in Counselling or a Diploma recognised by COSCA, BACP, UKCP or an equivalent body or will demonstrate training and application in one of the Brief Intervention modalities taught in this course.

### **Students Applying for RPL entry to Professional Supervision MSc Course**

Students seeking RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) will hold a hold a qualification in supervision or evidence supervision training coupled with significant supervision practice in their professional area. Applicants should have a qualification or demonstrate experience in the area in which they intend to supervise.

### **Applying for RPL**

Complete the form and with this application please submit a CV which details training and experience; a note of recommended heads for the CV is at the end of this document.

### **RPL Fees**

1. An assessment fee of £300 should accompany this application; this fee includes the assessment by CPTI and the university, a meeting with the applicant and a written report.
2. Fees in respect of any teaching, marking, assessments, tutorials and supervision of the master's project together with the matriculation and examination fees are calculated on an individual basis and will be notified in any written offer.
3. Unless exempted by recent research experience, completion of the CPTI taught Research Module is required, the fee for this is £365.
4. The payment of fees is required prior to matriculation on the course.

*Note that the degrees in Brief Intervention Psychological Therapies and Professional Supervision are subject to validation by Napier University; the TA degrees are validated by Queen Margaret University*

## CPTI MSc Programme Entry by RPL

RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) entry may offer exemptions to parts of the courses where the previous study can be demonstrated to have met the requirements of course modules. For exemption any previous qualification or award must be at the equivalent level and have been completed within the past five years.

All students seeking an MSc degree with RPL are required to submit to a process where their work is assessed; credit is allowed for 50% of course modules or their equivalent; on the basis of this assessment students agree what further course work is required together with the form of the MSc Project or Dissertation.
